CHALLENGES

Before adopting Birdview PSA, Intrahealth relied on a combination of unconnected tools for project/task planning, time tracking, resource management, reporting and documentation. These tools operated in silos, leading to inefficiencies in supporting the organization and overall marketplace growth objectives. RESULTS

Intrahealth successfully transitioned to a scalable, comprehensive project and resource management solution with Birdview PSA, leading to significant efficiency gains and future-proofing its operations. The organization achieved **improved resource planning and visibility**, consolidating all project-related data to enhance decision-making at the leadership level. Time savings were notable across multiple areas: leadership planning is estimated to save half a day per month, financial reporting is anticipated to save one full day per month for executive leadership by streamlining CAPEX reporting, and project managers are expected to save 30 minutes per week through improved reporting and tracking capabilities.

Additionally, the user-friendly interface led to higher compliance rates for time tracking submissions, ensuring more accurate data collection. Looking ahead, ongoing work on Business Intelligence (BI) reports is expected to provide deeper insights and further efficiency gains.
